Internship Training

We appreciate your desire to help expand the ministry of leading people to freedom in Christ. We believe that God has called us to care about people. He has also called us to help others learn to care for those around them. Training new counselors is strategic to our goals and we welcome the opportunity to include you in a hands-on experience in our Waterford, Vermont office. It is our desire that you will take this experience and multiply the ministry by caring for the hearts of people that God brings into your pathway.

RECOMMENDATIONS

We recommend that interns do each of the following before observing counseling.

1. View the series *Rekindling Marital Intimacy* by John Regier.
2. Complete the *Biblical Concepts in Counseling Workbook* with your spouse.
3. View the *Counselor Training Seminar* by John Regier.
4. Complete the *Counselor Training Seminar* Guide Booklet.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Contact our office for an Internship Application.
2. Schedule a time with our director to observe counseling
3. The cost: a one-time administrative fee of \$25 per individual intern or \$35 per married couple; then \$60 per case/per individual intern or \$100 per case/per married couple. All fees must be paid at or before Orientation.
4. Each intern must attend an Orientation Session before observing counseling. This Orientation should be scheduled with our director.
5. Write a paper (approximately 10 pages) on each case. Content of the paper should include:
 - a. History of the client
 - b. Define spiritual and emotional issues that are unresolved.
 - c. How you would resolve the issues and lead the client to freedom. [You are welcome to bring a laptop to use while observing.]
6. Clients take priority in our counseling sessions. If you, as an intern, know the individual/couple, you may be asked to leave during their sessions.

GUIDELINES

1. We want you to dress comfortably. The only guideline we have is modesty. [Ladies, no tight or low cut tops]
2. Water, coffee and hot water for tea will be provided in the intern room. Please feel free to bring snacks with you. A small refrigerator is available for your use.
3. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to each session.
4. Some people have allergies to perfumes/colognes. So we ask that you be sensitive to others.
5. We request that you not bring children with you.
6. Pray specifically for the counselee when he/she is struggling to resolve a spiritual/emotional issue.
